- Collaborating with the Press and Public Relations department in promoting projects and events
- Monitoring internal and external allocation of funding in the context of structural disadvantage within the assigned responsibilities
- Internal sensitization within the student union (ÖH) and creating 'safer spaces'
- Participating in relevant training sessions and networking meetings
- Attending university representation meetings and team meetings

The meetings of the AKG (Working Group on Equal Opportunities) at the University of Arts Linz are held in German. Therefore, German language skills are advantageous.
